Kane County Health Department is seeking proposals for a Teen Advisory Panel (TAP) for the tobacco REALITY program. One \$5,000.00 grant award is available during the period of October 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020. RFP responses are due no later than 3PM, Monday,

September 16, 2019.

REALITY Illinois is an in-your-face, stand-up-and-shout, not-taking-it-anymore anti-tobacco movement created by and for Illinois teens. Funded by the Illinois Department of Public Health and local health departments, REALITY Illinois is spreading the word about tobacco industry manipulation, second-hand smoke and tobacco use to everyone in the state.

Engaging Youth for Positive Change is a transformative process empowering young people to work with local governing bodies to adopt policies that create healthier communities. Targeted to youth ages 13-18, trained facilitators guide youth to identify the change they desire, learn about the workings of local governing bodies, engage friends, neighbors, and business leaders in their efforts, and communicate with elected officials to create change.
