### **Chic-A-Peas, LLC Recalls Product because of possible health risk**

The Kane County Health Department is advising that Chic-a-Peas, LLC is voluntarily recalling a limited number of **Chic-a -Peas Baked Crunchy Chickpeas 2 oz. packages** because the product has the potential to be contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes*.

No illnesses have been reported.
