

The Kane County Health Department encourages schools to adopt a layered approach to COVID-19 mitigation. Multiple layers of protection block the spread of COVID-19.

The KCHD recommends that Kane County schools closely monitor community transmission of COVID-19, vaccination coverage, screening testing and outbreaks to lead their decisions about the implementation of layered prevention strategies for in-person learning as outlined in the guidance provided in the <a href="IDPH/ISBE Revised Public Health Guidance for Schools">IDPH/ISBE Revised Public Health Guidance for Schools</a>.

KCHD recognizes that Kane County schools and their leaders are in the best position to assess the safety risks of their schools and to determine whether their schools should implement remote instruction in response to an unsafe environment.
