<p><b><i>Candida auris</i></b>  <i>Report 1<sup>st</sup>. C. auris event per patient, per encounter.</i></p>	<p>Report in INEDSS and XDRO Registry</p>	<p>Report within 3 days of test finalization</p>
<p><b>CRE (Carbapenem-resistant <i>Enterobacteriales</i>)</b></p> <p>Report <i>Enterobacteriales</i> with one of the following test results:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Molecular test (i.e. PCR) specific for carbapenemase resistance mechanism (KPC, NDM, VIM, IMP, OXA)</li> </ol> <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Phenotypic test (modified Carbapenem Inactivation Method)</li> </ol> <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. For <i>E. coli</i> and <i>Klebsiella spp.</i> only, non-susceptible to ONE of the carbapenems (doripenem, meropenem, or imipenem-disregard ertapenem) AND resistant to all third generation cephalosporins tested</li> </ol> <p><i>Report 1<sup>st</sup>. CRE event per patient, per encounter.</i></p>	<p>Report in INEDSS and XDRO Registry</p>	<p>Report within 3 days of test finalization</p>
<p><b>Vancomycin-resistant or -intermediate resistant <i>Staphylococcus aureus</i></b></p>	<p>Report in INEDSS</p>	<p>Report within 24 hours</p>
